Wehr Nature Center has provided refuge and environmental education for over 100,000 visitors from throughout southeast Wisconsin for five decades. The preserve is an oasis of 220 acres of nature trails through woodlands, wetlands, prairie and oak savannah.



On Sunday, September 15th, 2024 the Friends of Wehr's is hosting it's first-ever daytime gala event to gain support for the "Rooted and Growing" 50th anniversary fundraising campaign.
